Show Acorn. Ask if it will die if I bury it. It is a matter of perspective. To those who love the acorn more that the tree it will become, it will die. To those who love the tree, will finally come to life!

1 Cor 15:36-38

36 What a foolish question! When you put a seed into the ground, it doesn't grow into a plant unless it dies first. **37** And what you put in the ground is not the plant that will grow, but only a bare seed of wheat or whatever you are planting. **38** Then God gives it the new body he wants it to have. A different plant grows from each kind of seed.

1 Cor 15: 42

42 It is the same way with the resurrection of the dead. Our earthly bodies are planted in the ground when we die, but they will be raised to live forever.

1 Cor 15: 53

53 For our dying bodies must be transformed into bodies that will never die; our mortal bodies must be transformed into immortal bodies.

The end of the world for those who love this version of the earth better than new one:

2 Peter 3:7

7 And by the same word, the present heavens and earth have been stored up for fire. They are being kept for the day of judgment, when ungodly people will be destroyed.

But for us:

2 Peter 3: 11-13

11 Since everything around us is going to be destroyed like this, what holy and godly lives you should live, 12 looking forward to the day of God and hurrying it along. On that day, he will set the heavens on fire, and the elements will melt away in the flames. 13 But we are looking forward to the new heavens and new earth he has promised, a world filled with God's righteousness.

Heb 12:27-29

27 This means that all of creation will be shaken and removed, so that only unshakable things will remain.

28 Since we are receiving a Kingdom that is unshakable, let us be thankful and please God by worshiping him with holy fear and awe. 29 For our God is a devouring fire.
