(Rev 17:6-7) I saw the woman (Babylon), drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, <u>I marveled</u> with great amazement. But the angel said to me, "<u>Why did you marvel</u>? <u>I will tell you the mystery</u> of the woman and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and the ten horns.

Boredom ("Stay Thirsty" - Thirst Stealer)

He does Wonderful Works (Psa 40:5, 78:4, 107:8, 15, 21, 31, 111:4, 119:27)

What should His Church be like?

(Ps 36:7-9) How precious is Your <u>lovingkindness</u>, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings. For with You is the fountain of life; in Your light we see light.

We won't stay Bored: Competing Marvels/Pleasures vs <u>Surpassing</u> Pleasures in Him (<u>Je 2:11-13</u>) Has a nation changed its gods, which are not gods? But My people have <u>changed their Glory for what does not profit</u>. Be astonished, O heavens, at this, and be <u>horribly afraid</u>; be very desolate," says the LORD. "For My people have committed two evils: they have <u>forsaken Me</u>, the <u>fountain of living waters</u>, and <u>hewn themselves cisterns</u>—broken cisterns that can hold no water.

Choice (Mt 16:24-25) - begins with Self Denial, ends with Pleasure (life)

(Song 1:2-4) ²Let him kiss me with the <u>kisses</u> of his mouth - for your love is better than <u>wine</u>. ³Because of the <u>fragrance</u> of your good ointments, Your name is ointment poured forth; Therefore the virgins love you. ⁴Draw me away!

desire experiences (Ps 34:8), surpassing pleasure, presence (2 Cor 2:14), thirst for intimacy (Song 4:7-12, 15) ⁷You are all fair, my love, and there is no spot in you (Eph 5:27). ⁸Come with me ... ⁹You have ravished my heart, my sister, my spouse; you have ravished my heart with one look of your eyes, (response to our desire) ... ¹⁰How fair is your love, my sister, my spouse! How much better than wine is your love, (His pleasure in us) and the scent of your perfumes than all spices! (our presence/worship/prayer before Him) ¹¹Your lips, O my spouse, drip as the honeycomb; honey and milk are under your tongue; (His desire to engage us) and the fragrance of your garments is like the fragrance of Lebanon. ¹²A garden enclosed (1 Cor 3:16) is my sister, my spouse, ¹⁵A fountain of gardens, a well of living waters, (Jn 4:10, 14) (Song 4:16) Let my beloved come to his garden and eat its pleasant fruits. come into Your garden - enjoy me
